What planter do you have, and what plate did you purchase?

- KZ 3500 Splitter; 8/15 with the 48-cell bean plate and Backer Plate

What did you plant?

- Oats; and Rye (Nov 7th plant) into the corn stalks; Separate plants

- I knew what the purpose of the plate was, and I considered making them myself but need the convenience of a precision-made product; simple but well-constructed

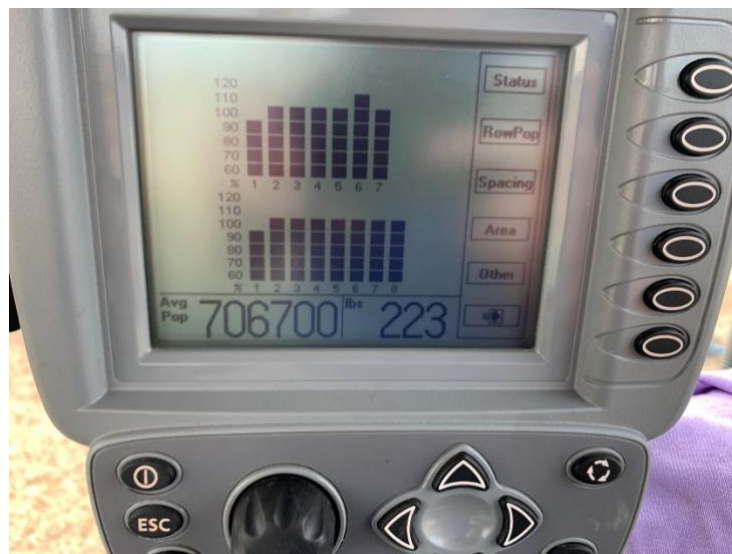
What is your final impression after using the plates?
