What planter was used?

- John Deere DB60; Twin Row; using 12" and 8" row spacing

What SeedRight plate?

- John Deere Large Cell; PN: PLJD-AA0030L

What did you plant?

- 25 pounds of barley, 12 pounds of edible beans, 2-3 pounds of radish

Why did you choose the SeedRight plates?

- "My son did all the research on them, and we wanted something that would do small seed along with barley and would also do an edible pinto bean. They worked perfectly. Absolutely perfect. I like the cells because they are oblong so you can get the edible bean in there."

What was your first impression upon seeing the plates?

- "I think they're gonna work."

What is your final impression after using the SeedRight plates?
